MOVE-UP REGULATIONS: Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made in writing or via email to the trial secretary ONLY. Move-ups for Saturday, April 18 must be received no later than 6:00PM on Monday, April 13. Move-ups for Sunday will be accepted until the last ribbon has been awarded on the previous day. Dogs so moved up will be entered at the end of the running order, and every effort will be made to accommodate handlers running multiple dogs in the same class.

WAIT LIST: This club is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the closing date. A maximum of 50 entries will be placed on the wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to closing date, April 6, 2026 at 6:00PM. Any entries withdrawn by April 12, 2026 at 6:00PM will be replaced by wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list and into the trial as a result of an entry pulled by April 12, 2026 will have their entry check shredded or voided and returned upon request.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS: Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. Judges reserve the right to measure all dogs without a valid height card. Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division in the Regular program, but not in a lower division than their proper height division. Dogs entered in Preferred MUST run in their proper height division.

DIRECTION TO TRIAL SITE:

From I-294 or I94, Exit at I-57 south. Continue south to exit 355 to Manhattan-Monee Road. Continue West on Manhattan-Monee Road to Route 45. Turn Left (south) on route 45 for about 2.5 miles to the trial site

ENTRY: Entry fee is \$26.00 for the first entry, \$18.00 for the second and additional entry of the same dog per day (includes AKC recording fee). Mail entries, maximum of 10 per envelope, with fees payable to **JPAWS Agility**, to Jim Payne, 1139 Mary Jane Lane, Beach Park, IL 60099. Worker Coupons earned at past PPBAC trials may be used as a credit towards entry fees. Include the PPBAC worker coupons with your entry. Express mail entries **MUST** waive the signature requirement or they will be refused. Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms, and the correct entry fee. Checks returned due to non-sufficient funds will be assessed a \$30.00 fee. All illegible or incomplete forms or those with insufficient entry fees will be returned.

Electronic entries will be accepted. Email your completed and signed entry form to the trial secretary. A Square invoice will be emailed to you (including a 3.3% + \$0.30 service fee). Once your payment has been received, your entry will be processed. You can download a fillable entry form from this link:

Notification of entry status prior to closing will be emailed to all exhibitors providing an email address. Any exhibitor that does not have an email address should send a SASE or postcard to be returned with their entry status information. No other acknowledgement of entry status will be given. Exhibitors with an email address are responsible for making sure their email address is legible and that any email from the trial secretary is not blocked by spam blockers or rejected due to a full mailbox.

Final entry confirmations and judging schedule will be sent after the final closing date to all exhibitors, as per Chapter 1, Section 19 of the regulations for Agility Trials. Exhibitors providing an email address will be emailed their confirmation, exhibitors with no email address or whose email confirmations bounced, will be sent their confirmations via USPS.

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Entering for Exhibition Only (FEO)

FEO allows exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is offered in all classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.

- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Handler has 45 seconds for Standard, JWW and Time 2 Beat classes (course time in FAST). Exhibitors must quickly move towards the exit when the horn sounds.
- Dogs may be entered in any level. If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring. Toys must be non-audible and may not leave the handlers hand. Toys that roll freely may not be used.
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER: This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners Listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

MEASURING: Exhibitors are no longer required to submit a copy of their dog's jump height card with their entry or show it the day of the show at check in. It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS: Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, excused, disqualified, or barred from the competition by action of the Show Committee. No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

A full refund will be issued for bitches in season or in the event of a major medical occurrence. Written notification must be given to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the first class the day of the trial. The Trial Committee may require additional written documentation prior to issuing the refund.

Dogs are not required to be at the trial until the scheduled time of judging, however handlers arriving after the scheduled course walk through for their class has taken place are not guaranteed a chance to walk the course. All dogs not needed for further judging are excused. The owner/handler is solely responsible for being ready at ringside when the class is to be judged.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated warm-up areas. Exhibitors and spectators are expected to keep the show grounds clean. Please pick up after your dogs. Anyone witnessed not picking up after their dog will be excused from the trial weekend with no monies refunded.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

SITE INFORMATION: The agility trial will be held at Rush 'N' Around Agility and Obedience Center in Manhattan, IL. NO motor homes will be allowed. Food will not be available on site. There will be no crating allowed inside the building.

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division. All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running. Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
