- **Telephone, Fax, Email and Unsigned Entries CANNOT Be Accepted.** Entries not on official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.
- **Mail All Entries with Fees to:** Bobbi Schwabe, 3349 Michigan Street, Hobart, IN 46342. Entries received without fees will not be accepted.
- **Make checks payable to Paw Power Blues Agility Club of N.W. Indiana.** Show Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.
- **Entry Fees** shall not be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.
- **Returned Checks** do not constitute a valid entry fee. A \$35.00 Collection Fee will be charged for ALL returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in them being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
- **Errors on Entry Blanks.** Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fees will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after published closing date.
- **A full refund (minus \$10 per class administration fees) will be issued for bitches in season or in the event of a major medical occurrence. Written notification must be given to the trial secretary at least 1 hour prior to the start of the first class on the day of the trial. The Trial Committee may require additional written documentation prior to issuing the refund.**
- Limited Crating space available. **MATTING REQUIRED UNDER ALL CRATES.**
- All Dogs Present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged. All dogs must be on leash outside the building, including exercise areas – Lowell ordinance.
- Dogs May only be exercised in designated areas outside the building. No exercise pens are allowed in the building. Dogs may not be left in the building overnight.
- Dogs Not Entered in the Show may not be present in the building.
- Move ups allowed with proper information. Move ups must be presented to trial secretary ½ hour prior to start of each trial.
- No Smoking is allowed in the building. Absolutely No Alcoholic Beverages or non-prescribed drugs will be allowed on the grounds. Paw Power Blues Agility Club of N.W. Indiana reserves the right to deny all future entries of exhibitors who fail to comply with these rules.
- Lunch Will be available for a donation at the show site, however, there are many establishments in the immediate area where food can be purchased.
- **HEALTH STATEMENT:** Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to ensure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. The dog exercise area is on the east side of the Paw Power Blues building.
