Beginner Obedience

Classes introduce the fundamentals of the beginner and novice obedience skills. Focus will be on developing the relationship between handler and dog while learning the basic trial skills; attention, heeling; recall, and stays, both on and off leash.

In this class students will continue learning competition skills while being introduced to the basics of obedience trials. Skills for advanced, open and utility titles will be practiced. Students will be working both on and off leash, learning obedience skills to include directed jumping, dumbbell retrieval and hand signals.

RALLY OBEDIENCE

Rally is all about teamwork. You and your dog navigate a course together, side-by-side, at your own brisk pace. You move your dog through a course with signs where you perform different exercises. The courses are designed by the Rally judge (10-20 signs per course, depending on the class level) that include various turns and commands such as sit, down, stay, etc.
