UDX Class (Dogs entered in this class will be entered in both Open B and Utility and the combined entry fee for these two classes must be paid. Once the limit has been reached in either Class, the UDX Class will be considered closed and any subsequent entries for this class will be unacceptable in their entirety.)

Obedience Entries **limited to maximum of 8 hours of judging per day.**

Classes will be considered closed when limit is reached even if this occurs before the official closing date.

SPECIAL NOTICE TO RALLY NOVICE AND ADVANCED EXHIBITORS:

The Rally Novice A class is for dogs and handlers that have not earned ANY AKC Rally titles or AKC Obedience titles. The Rally Advanced A class is for DOGS that have earned the RN title, but have not earned the RA title or ANY AKC Obedience titles. The Excellent A class is for dogs that have not earned the RE title or ANY Obedience title.

Rally Pairs Class (Novice only offered). Rally Pairs class consists of competition by one handler working two dogs at one time through a rally course at a level selected and offered by the event-giving club. **Fee-\$21 per pair.**

Rally Team Competition (Novice only offered). The Rally Team Competition will be for teams of any four dogs that are eligible under these Regulations. Five dogs may be entered, one to be considered an alternate for which no entry fee will be required; however, the same four dogs will perform all of the signs. No dog may be entered on more than one team. There is a total possible score of 400 points for each team. All team members will run the course individually, with the team time running continuously. **Fee-\$21 per team.**

Errors On Entry Blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors and no entry fees will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after published closing date.

Refund Of Entry Fees for bitches that come in season after the closing date of this Show may be obtained (minus AKC fees) by sending a veterinarian's certificate to the Show Secretary. This certificate must be postmarked before the opening day of the show or given to the Show Secretary before the start of the Show.

Limited Crating space available. **MATTING REQUIRED UNDER ALL CRATES.**

All Dogs Present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged. All dogs must be on leash outside the building – Lowell ordinance. This also includes designated exercise areas.

Dogs May only be exercised in designated areas outside the building. No exercise pens allowed in the building.

Dogs Not Entered in the Show may not be present in the building.

Move ups allowed with proper information. Move ups must be presented to trial secretary ½ hour prior to start of each trial.

Dogs May Not be left in the building overnight. **No Smoking** is allowed in the building.

Absolutely No Alcoholic Beverages or non-prescribed drugs will be allowed on the grounds. To insure this does not happen, Paw Power Blues Agility Club of N.W. Indiana reserves the right to deny all future entries of exhibitors who fail to comply with these rules.

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e. Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color.) Beagles (not exceeding 13 in. over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.) Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired) Collies (rough, smooth,) Bull Terriers (colored, white.) Manchester Terriers (standard, toy.) Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat.) English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles,) Poodles (toy, miniature, standard.)

- (Event Class) Consult the classification in the premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to AKC (For complete rule refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
