\*When entries are limited, a club must designate an RAE and a Rally Champion (RACH) class in the premium list. Dogs entered in the RAE class would be entered in both Advanced B and Excellent B, and the combined entry fee for these two classes must be paid. If due to entry limits an exhibitor cannot be entered in both the Advanced B and Excellent B classes the RAE class will be considered closed and any subsequent entries for this class will be unacceptable in their entirety. Dogs entered in the RACH class would be entered in Advanced B, Excellent B and the Master class. The combined entry fee for these three classes must be paid. ## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

### Telephone, Fax, Email and Unsigned Entries CANNOT Be Accepted.

Entries not on official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms **without** Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

**Mail All Entries with Fees to** Lorraine Frendling, 9100 Drake Drive, St. John, IN 46373. Entries received without fees will not be accepted. **Make checks payable to Paw Power Blues Agility Club of N.W. Indiana.** Show Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.

**Entry Fees** shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.

**Returned Checks** do not constitute a valid entry fee. **A \$35.00 Collection Fee will be charged for ALL returned checks.** Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a **CASH ONLY** basis.

**Errors on Entry Blanks.** Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors and no entry fees will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after published closing date.

**A full refund (minus AKC fees)** will be issued for bitches in season or in the event of a major medical occurrence. Written notification must be given to the trial secretary at least 1 hour prior to the start of the first class the day of the trial. The Trial Committee may require additional written documentation prior to issuing the refund.

**Limited Crating** space available. **MATTING REQUIRED UNDER ALL CRATES.**

**All Dogs Present** must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged. All dogs must be on leash outside the building – Lowell ordinance. This also includes designated exercise areas.

**Dogs May** only be exercised in designated areas outside the building. No exercise pens allowed in the building.

**Dogs Not Entered in the Show** may not be present in the building. Move ups allowed with proper information. Move ups must be presented to trial secretary ½ hour prior to start of each trial.

**Dogs May Not** be left in the building overnight. **No Smoking** is allowed in the building.

**Absolutely No Alcoholic Beverages** or non-prescribed drugs will be allowed on the grounds. To insure this does not happen, Paw Power Blues Agility Club of N.W. Indiana reserves the right to deny all future entries of exhibitors who fail to comply with these rules.

**Lunch Will** be available for a donation at the show site, however, there are many establishments in the immediate area where food can be purchased.

## **HEALTH STATEMENT:**

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Entries **open** at Show Secretary's Office 12:00 p.m. CST, **Saturday, January 21, 2023.** Entries **close Wednesday, March 8, 2023** or when limits have been reached, after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the AKC Dog Show Rules.

- 1.(Variety) if you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color.) Beagles (not exceeding 13 in. over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.) Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired) Collies (rough, smooth,) Bull Terriers (colored, white.) Manchester Terriers (standard, toy,) Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat,) English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles,) Poodles (toy, miniature, standard.)
2.The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition; Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3.(Event Class) Consult the classification in the premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4.A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to AKC (For complete rule refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
