Dogs entered in the RAE class would be entered in both Advanced B and Excellent B, and the combined entry fee for these two classes must be paid. If due to entry limits an exhibitor cannot be entered in both the Advanced B and Excellent B classes the RAE class will be considered closed and any subsequent entries for this class will be unacceptable in their entirety. Dogs entered in the RACH class would be entered in Advanced B, Excellent B and the Master class. The combined entry fee for these three classes must be paid. If due to entry limits an exhibitor cannot be

entered in the Advanced B, Excellent B and Master classes the RACH class will be considered closed and any subsequent entries for this class will be unacceptable in their entirety.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. A \$35.00 Collection Fee will be charged for ALL returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

We have new matting so please make sure your chairs have rubber feet so they do not dig into the matting.


All Dogs Present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged. All dogs must be on leash outside the building – This also includes designated exercise areas.

Dogs Not Entered in the Show may not be present in the building. Transfers allowed with proper information. Transfer forms must be presented secretary $\frac{1}{2}$ hour prior to start of each trial.

Dogs May Not be left in the building overnight. No Smoking building.

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition; Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship. 3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in the premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.

4.A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
